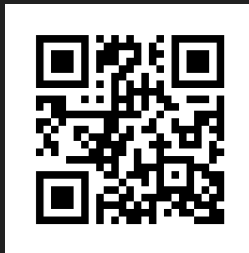
AAO SECTION ON CCLRT CASE REPORT AND CONCEPT CHALLENGE
